

## Non-Executive Director Workshop

### Why?

As IS leaders become established in director-level positions, so the question of 'what next' can become pressing. For ambitious CIOs, non-executive director roles are an attractive way of growing into positions of wider influence and reward. The transition to broader non-executive roles, however, is not always straightforward and effective preparation is crucial.

### Who Should Attend?

This programme is for established CIOs and senior IS leaders in large organisations. It will be especially valuable to CIOs looking to prepare for non-executive director roles.
